From The Pastors Desk... February 2022

A writer by the name of Joshua Bowron writes a lot about FORGIVENESS.

He writes about **the two-way track on which forgiveness occurs.** That's an important point since we often think only in terms of forgiveness being something we either give to others or expect... sometimes even demand of others. That is the **ONE-WAY STREET idea of forgiveness.**

Forgiveness involves at least two people: One who is ready to offer forgiveness and the other who receives it or wants it or demands it.

This is the **TWO-WAY STREET** of the **process** of forgiveness. Forgiveness can only genuinely occur when we (two or more people) become involved in the TWO-WAY STREET ways of giving, receiving, reciprocating...forgiveness.

It is the **TWO-WAY STREET model** of forgiveness to which Jesus Christ calls us. He doesn't give us **any** choice. Demanding forgiveness is not adequate or acceptable to Jesus according to the Scriptures. Simply offering forgiveness is not adequate or acceptable to Jesus according to the Scriptures.

Genuine forgiveness is NOT demanded or "expected" of another. Neither is genuine forgiveness (in the Biblical sense) **simply offered** to another without a genuine ENGAGEMENT between the giver and the recipient of the act of forgiveness.

These all sound pretty easy to most of us most of the time. But there always seem to be roadblocks of various sorts. One of the biggest roadblocks has to do with our *perceptions of ourselves*.

It is nearly impossible to receive or give forgiveness, as Jesus tells us we are to do, when **one of the persons involved "knows" that she or he is "good" and the other is "bad**". In other words, as either recipients of forgiveness or those giving it to others, **if we say we are without sin and** the other is sinful we deceive ourselves and destroy the act of forgiveness.

There is no harder thing than seeking or receiving forgiveness when you are convinced you are "good" while the other is "bad". And the Holy Scriptures are crystal clear about this.

It is those who are *convinced of their own righteousness* who should scare us say the Scriptures; not those who genuinely offer or are open to receiving forgiveness.

May our Good and Loving God give each of us the strength to shed our assumptions about *our own* **superiority** in order to liberate our capacities to give and receive forgiveness....as Christ commanded.

CHANCEL GUILD A MINISTRY OF SERVICE

What is Per Capita?

"All Presbyterians are individually called to take part in the ecclesiastical and administrative work shared by the whole church through per capita giving."

Per Capita is a set amount of money (apportionment) per member that congregations pay to the larger Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). Per Capita goes back to 1734. Simply put, annually, congregations pay to their respective presbyteries a per-member set amount of money. <u>Every Presbyterian</u> shares in the benefit of the apportionment; it is part of the glue that holds us - we Presbyterians together as a Body of Christ, by supporting the various ministries. To this end, it is a form of stewardship. It is Fairgreen's stewardship to Presbytery.

I am concerned that many members of our congregation, for some reason, fail to pay their per capita. Currently we have 76 members in our congregation:

 $76 \times \$37.25 = \2831.00 . When we don't pay our per capita, Fairgreen Church funds pay the balance even though we are in a deficit budget.

I am hopeful that you will pay your per capita of \$37.25 in 2022. In the front of each Giving Packet is an envelope marked **Per Capita** – **in Red**. If you are unable to pay that amount all at once, please talk with Marilyn McAfee and develop a payment plan that is comfortable for you.



We also ask Tricia to put out emails to the congregation for produce availability in the kitchen. Tammy also has connections with other churches and pantries, and we share with them, creating a reciprocal relationship with other organizations working to service the hungry of the city.
