### On the Wings of God's Grace: Lessons Learned from the Birds of the Air

Some of the most expressive illustrations of divine love and care are taken from the ways of birds in the Bible. Psalm 36:7 speaks of God's love:

"How precious is your steadfast love, O God! All people may take refuge in the shadow."

While Psalm 91:4 tells of God as our refuge:

"...he will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge."

For our Women's Retreat in February 2020, we will be visiting, studying, singing, and praying some of these scriptures as we bring to light the importance of birds, biblically and spiritually, and how they speak of our relationship with the Lord.

Dear Fairgreen Friends and Family,



### **OCTOBER/NOVEMBER SESSION SUMMARY by Karen Herren**

### **OCTOBER**

Quorum established by Pastor Alex McLean; Opening Prayer & devotion read by Elder Joyce Koback. Two PNC Committee Representatives attended this meeting, Patti Nordhoff & Peg Winslow, as well as Elder Dale Herren.

PNC provided a copy of the Mission Information Form (MIF) to Session for approval before sending to MVP Committee on Ministry. This is required before the Committee can begin receiving Pastor Information Forms (PIF)

The following people were taken into the membership of Fairgreen Church: PATSY ANSTED, DANNY KRAMER, JR., JEREMY METHENA, AGNES McKINSTRY, ALYSSA POPE, MELANIE ROGERS and ZANDRA WILLIAMS on 9/9/2019

Pastor Alex McLean attended the MVP Meeting at 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian Church in Findlay; he reported Grace Presbyterian Church has an active buyer; he attended an "Open Space" break-out class on gun violence.

**WORSHIP** – Charlene Ravenscraft continues to secure individuals to fill Fairgreen's pulpit

**INTENTIONAL FAITH DEVELOPMENT TEAM – Mike Roadruck provided update on Ministry Activities** 

**MISSION & OUTREACH** – Printed report with dates for upcoming church events; spaghetti Dinner proceeds were \$619.00; Taco Football Friday – the committee is trying to get a bigger response to participate

**LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES** has given \$700.00 (grant) to replace a refrigerator for the Food Pantry

**TREASURER'S REPORT** — printed report; Peg Winslow provided a hard copy highlighting the large deficient budget we are facing for this year.

**PERSONNEL COMMITTEE** — employee handbook revision is finalized; staff evaluations will be scheduled

**BUILDING & GROUNDS – Verbal report by Fred Nordhoff** 

**MOTIONS APPROVED BY SESSION:** Agenda approved; Minutes from 9/3/19 approved; Mission Information Form approved; approved sending a check Great Banquet Funds to their new location at Zion Lutheran Church in Waterville, in the amount of \$20,414.43; to accept all reports presented at this meeting; to Adjourn

### **NOVEMBER**

Quorum established; opening devotions & prayer.

Pastor Alex McLean is attending the MVP Meeting on 11/19/19 in Van Wert, OH @ 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian Church; no elder is available to attend as Commissioner

Correspondence received from the Ohio Dept of Commerce titled, "Institution Notice for Liquor Permit" advising Fairgreen of the liquor license at Dollar General Store # 21050 5009 Secor Rd., Toledo, OH 43623. Session checked the line item stating "We request the Division of Liquor Control document our objection to the issuance of this permit but we do not request a hearing. In choosing this option I understand that it is only an objection for the record and will not adversely impact the issuance of this permit." The document was signed by the Clerk of Session & returned to the Ohio Dept of Commerce via the Administration Assistant. (Copy will be on file in the church office)

Mission & Outreach does not wish to be responsible for the following: 1) Hospital Visitation; 2) home bound & Nursing Home Visitation, 3) Benevolence......discussion followed; no decision was reached

Peg Winslow, Bookkeeper, prepared a typed financial report for the Session; we transferred \$25,000 from our investment funds; offerings through 10/31/19 are \$71,000, which is about equal to what the 2020 minimum terms of call will cost for a full time pastor (10 months of offerings); we are \$40,000 behind where offerings were at the same time in 2018. NEXT YEAR'S OFFERING WILL BE LOWER THAN THIS YEAR' maintaining our building costs as \$55,000 - \$60,000. This includes utilities, snow removal, mowing, repairs, maintenance, insurance, property taxes & custodial supplies; It does not include large projects such as the boiler nor does it include the salary of the custodian.

Memorial Fund balance is \$11,583.11

Building & Grounds had a thermostatically controlled exhaust fan installed in the storage room's ceiling venting the heat into the rafter area above the Commons. A new refrigerator was received from grant money & the two older ones in the storage were recycled. Storage area vacated by the Great Banquet supplies has been equitably repurposed.

**MOTIONS PASSED BY SESSION:** Elder Bonnie Buehrer elected as Clerk Pro-tem in the absence of the Clerk of Session; Agenda approved; Session Minutes from 10/3/19 as amended; Session elected which box to choose on the letter from the Ohio Department of Commerce regarding liquor sales at Dollar General; the Mission & Outreach motion to not be responsible for 3 items in their committee structure failed to pass – a motion to drop the 3 items mentioned passed; Session approved spending up to \$8,000.00 for the replacement of the current portable hot water boiler that is in need of replacement.....the current one was installed 26 years ago & is in need of repair or replacement; approval to sell the church van for not less than \$25;00.00; Elder Dale Herren has completed the required MVP training to celebrate the Lord's Supper in Fairgreen's congregation per letter received from the Rev Robert E. Butcher, Instructor – Session approval was required (letter on file in the church office); any committee that earns money that adds to their budget will be allowed to spend those funds without prior Session approval; to accept all committee reports; to adjourn
