God has created an amazing family in the people here at Fairgreen. By God's Grace we have weathered these times before and we will again. God already knows who He has chosen as Fairgreen's next pastor, whether it will be a full time or part time pastor remains to be seen.

Let's join together to be in prayer for our next pastor. . . seek God's will, be FAITH-FUL; be STEADFAST in your prayer time; be CONSTANT in coming to church and continue to be consistent in your financial giving, your time, your energy.


MARK YOUR CALENDAR FOR THE CELEBRATION!

A NOTE FROM BUILDING AND GROUNDS by Fred Nordhoff

Fairgreen Church Building and Grounds committee is calling for all able bodied and faithfully willing sisters and brothers in Christ to devote some of their time toward sprucing up specific areas of the Church. We will need all work accomplished by May 31, 2019. The Building and Grounds committee soon will establish a set date for a large group effort. In the mean-time, all who enjoy working by themselves or like working together with friends are encouraged to complete the tasks that are listed below.

Sanctuary/Narthex

- A. Emphasis is on vacuuming behind and under baseboard heaters and pews and corresponding seat cushions.
- B. All wooden furniture, from the main floor to the Chancel should be washed.
- C. As temperatures allow, the windows can be washed.

Commons

- A. Repair any tables and chairs, as well as washing them.
- B. Cleaning out clutter and washing surfaces as practicable in the three utility rooms.

<u>Library</u>

A. Thought on how we can repurpose this room for other uses. Much of what is there is unused or no longer relevant to the current make-up of the congregation, so work emphasis will be toward dusting and cleaning.

Walkway and Memorial Garden Areas

- A. Clearing out last years weeds and dead flower stubble and prepping the ground for current planting is needed.
- B. Clearing and leveling most the bed to the right side of the garden walkway as this bed will be returned to turfgrass.
- C. Perennials will be saved and transplanted to other bed areas.

Other work can be done in addition to bed prep as volunteers see the need, yet share your ideas with the Building and Grounds committee. The committee members are: Dale Herren, Fred Ahrens, Fred Nordhoff, Chris Roebuck, and Agnes McKinstry. Also you can share with Danny Kramer and Sheila Ortmann.


