From The Pastors Desk...

Without much warning the ground began to shake. Almost everyone at the hospital knew what to do... get outside of the hospital in case it fell. Because of the history of earthquakes in this area, all the staff of the hospital knew... they knew this earthquake was going to last long and could bring buildings down. They knew it might collapse on them. They knew it might kill them. So virtually all of the staff knew the smart thing to do was to run and get outside of the building as fast as possible.

That's what most of the staff did, leaving patients unattended inside the shaking building.

That's what most of the staff did except two nurses whose reactions were caught on video. These two nurses ran <u>toward their patients</u>. They were seeking to tend to the needs of their patients. You see, their patients were new born babies in the neo-natal care unit.

These nurses were determined that none of the new born babies would suffer or die. These nurses were determined to stay with the babies.

In the videos you can see the rooms shaking where the babies were... so much that all the furniture was sliding from one side of the room to the other... back and forth... back and forth... including the beds the little babies were in.

After what seemed like an eternity, the shaking stopped. But the walls and ceilings of the hospital did not stop falling.

At first, the neo-natal ward seemed to be safe. It turned out that wasn't the case. The two nurses each took three newly born babies, gently laid them on the floor in their blankets and covered them with their own bodies.

When rescuers came looking for survivors, they found the neo-natal ward and pushed away the rubble hoping to find that at least one of the newly born babies was somehow alive.

When the rubble was cleared, the rescuers found six babies still alive. They also found the bodies of two nurses who had been killed by the falling debris.

Someone asked: "Where was God in all of this death and destruction?" I don't know for sure. I am guessing God was at work in the hearts and minds of two nurses who saved the lives of six newly born babies. May our hearts and minds be as attuned to the life and death needs of others.
