Oh Look! Sunflowers!

Whether you are attending a church service in person or on Zoom, you will see sunflowers as part of the Fairgreen sanctuary decor! This is an intentional part of the October Stewardship emphasis as we look at how we recognize God's presence among us.

Why sunflowers? Well, they are bright and cheerful-looking. They are in bloom right now and for many people, this flower is a symbol of adoration. A sunflower belongs to the group of plants that follow the movement of the sun. This is called solar-tracking or heliotropism. These plants face the light of the rising sun in the eastern sky at dawn and follow it until the sun sinks below the western horizon at dusk.

Seeing a sunflower is a good reminder that we, too, are to keep our thoughts and hearts on the Son and to daily follow Jesus, our Light of the world.

As Jesus guides us through each day, let us be Doxology people, expressing thanksgiving, praise, adoration, and glory to God for the love of His Son as our Savior and for the presence of His Spirit as our strength.

Giving God the Glory

Praise God from whom all blessings. Praise Him all creatures here below. Praise Him above ye heavenly hosts, Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost!

What is written above may be familiar to you. It is called a Doxology. It is an expression of praise to God.

A doxology is a hymn or verse in Christian liturgy glorifying God, often sung or chanted. The tradition comes from a similar practice in the Jewish synagogue. As you remember from the September <u>Leaves</u>, the word doxology comes from the Greek **doxologia** meaning praise or glory. It is the combination of **doxa**: "glory" and **logos**: "a speaking" or word.


Doxology is the chosen theme for our Stewardship Time during the month of October.

Here at Fairgreen, we have much for which to give praise to God and yet, if you are like me, I sometimes forget from Whom all our blessings flow! This will be a time to sing and say, hear and pray and become freshly aware of the goodness of God's blessings not only upon us as individuals, but as the Fairgreen Body of Christ and upon those in our outreach ministries.

Watch for doxologies found in both the Old and New Testaments! You will find different ones printed on the back of the bulletin each Sunday.
